- What are the challenges facing the Board of Assessors?
- What is your position on ensuring assessed property values truly reflect the value of the parcel and property in question?

Candidate statement

I am a retired Engineer and for 25 years the owner of a small business. I first ran for a vacant Assessor's position three years ago because I believe in Town government and wanted to help out as best I could. In those three years I have worked with my fellow Assessors to make the Assessor's office more customer-friendly and to insure the continuation of our history of fair and equitable treatment of all tax-payers.

The main job of the Assessor's office is to see that all property in Town is valued correctly so that no tax-payer or group of tax-payers are paying an unfair share of the Town's tax base. To that end we are constantly on the look-out for properties that are either under-valued or over-valued due to human error, changes in market conditions, or misrepresentation by their owners. Such diligence has resulted in over \$1 million in new tax revenue to the Town in my first term as your Assessor. With your help I will be able to continue this work.
